



1940S-1960S SWEDISH FLYGVAPNET DRIVERS

From the early 1940s, Flygvapnet Ground crews wore a heavy dark blue somewhat unshapely cloth uniform while maintaining aircraft. After some time they could get quite worn and faded. They mostly wore garrison caps and sometimes olive green field caps sourced from the Army, from the 1960s the m/59 cap. Woollen hats could also be worn in colder seasons. In winter white parkas were sometimes worn over the blue uniforms. The blue uniform was apparently not worn during the secondment to the Congo. In the very late 1960s, the **olive drab** so called överdragsbyxa grön or överdragsjacka grön, which translates to "Green workwear.
