



1970-1980s SWEDISH FLYGVAPNET GROUND CREW

In the late 1960s, the **olive drab** so called överdragsbyxa grön or överdragsjacka grön, which translates to “Green workwear,” replaced the heavy faded dark blue and somewhat unshapely cotton mechanic’s uniform used at least since the early 1940s. It was used together with the olive drab m/59 field cap, which was sourced from the Swedish army. For day to day use, **officers** were issued the m/1948 flight jackets, m/1930 trousers and standard m/1930 garrison caps all in **dark blue**. For formal occasions, there were a dress uniforms, not provided here.
