SWEDISH 19405 M/39 UNIFORMED TANK CREWS

The heavy wool m/39 Battle Dress Uniform was introduced in 1939 on the eve of WWII and was used, often in parallel with the large m/43 overall, during the rest of the 1940s. The uniform was gray-brown-green. Tank crews also wore m/39 uniforms with jodhpurs, large black berets and black leather helmets. In winter, the crews wore thick black motorcycle jackets, not provided here. The Figures are suitable for the Gecko Heavy industries Strv m/41, Strv m/42, Stormartillerivagn m/43, and Pansarvärnskanonvagn m/43 as well as Strv m/39 and m/40 from other manufacturers.
